

Ended: High Streamflow Advisory – Central Coast

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** the **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Central Coast, including the Bella Coola River and Atnarko River**

The rivers in this region have responded to the warm temperatures in the past week and are expected to be stable below the concerned levels, even if minor rises could be possible.

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
