## COMMUNITY COMMUNICATION #3

February 27, 2021

Our response to the positive COVID19 case on Denny Island identified yesterday is ongoing. All appropriate precautions are being taken, but the following steps must be followed to ensure that the virus does not spread.

Under advisement of our local medical professionals, we are taking the following steps:

- 1. Please No Travel between Denny Island and Bella Bella until at least March 5th, 2021
  - a. This may be extended
  - b. This includes travel for all work
  - c. The Seabus will only be operating for Mail and/or Medical
  - d. All services on Denny Island will remain closed to non-Denny Island residents
  - Going forward if there is a case on EITHER Denny Island or Bella Bella we will be
    asking that both communities DO NOT travel between islands until contact
    tracing has been completed.
  - f. Medical travel is allowed. Residents of Denny Island should go directly to and from the "Princess"/Gov Dock to the Hospital without making any additional stops
  - g. We thank Shearwater and Denny Island residents for working with us on this and helping to keep our communities safe together
- Please continue to take all precautions listed in communication #1 and #2, and stay
  within your household bubbles until Contact Tracing has been completed and a NOTICE
  from the EOC states that.
- At this time we are unsure if there has been spread to Bella Bella or how widespread
  the virus is currently on Denny Island and as such are taking measures to ensure the
  safety of communities on Denny Island and Bella Bella.
- It is extremely important that if you are experiencing any flu-like symptoms you call
  the Hospital to be tested, this will help us to determine how far the virus has spread into
  community.
  - REMEMBER by getting tested you are HELPING our communities.
  - b. No one is immune to this virus and it can be easily spread, it is not one person's fault if they contract the virus and we must treat everyone with respect and kindness. If a person tests positive they will need community support and understanding.
