Total Active Cases as of January 22, 2021: 31

Number of cases considered resolved: 30

January 22, 2021 - Number of cases to date: 61

The Nuxalk EOC is requesting that we follow COVID-19 protocols:

- 1. Please get a test if you have any symptoms: call Public Health Nurse Sophie Mack 250.799.5902 or Amy Pootlass to book an appointment for a test 250.799.5441
- STAY AT HOME REQUEST for all individuals in the Nuxalk Nation until further notice. Please do not visit outside your household. This is very important to help stop the spread of the virus.
- A CURFEW is in effect IMMEDIATELY from 9PM to 6AM If there are large parties or gatherings, the RCMP will be notified.
- 4. WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES SOCIAL DISTANCE WASH YOUR HANDS
- 5. Only essential services will be provided from the band office for the next two weeks (January 8 26, 2021)
- 6. The Nuxalk EOC is active and will work full time.
- BE KIND. This virus does not discriminate.
- 8. Check in on your elderly relatives and those with compromised immune systems by TELEPHONE
- If you are returning HOME FROM TRAVEL, YOU MUST SELF ISOLATE FOR 7 DAYS AND STRICTLY SELF-MONITOR FOR SYMPTOMS
- 10. Limit any travel out of the valley to medical needs ONLY
- 11. Please do **NOT** invite any visitors from out-of-town.
- 12. Contact tracing is STILL in progress

Symptoms include cough, fever, chills, shortness of breath, headache, runny nose, muscle aches, fatigue, loss of smell or taste, sore throat, nausea and vomiting, diarrhea, loss of appetite
