

Community Update #3 re: Bella Coola COVID-19 cases

January 9, 2021 - Number of Active Cases: 11

The Nuxalk EOC is requesting that we follow COVID-19 protocols:

- 1. Please get a test if you have any symptoms: call Public Health Nurse Sophie Mack 250.799.5902
- 2. STAY AT HOME REQUEST for all individuals in the Nuxalk Nation until further notice. Please do not visit outside your household. This is extremely important to help stop the spread of the virus.
- 3. A CURFEW is in effect IMMEDIATELY from 9PM to 6AM Please expect the Safety Patrol to be doing rounds in the coming days. If there are large parties or gatherings, the RCMP will be notified.
- 4. WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES SOCIAL DISTANCE WASH YOUR HANDS
- 5. Only essential services will be provided from the band office for the next two weeks (January 8 26, 2021)
- 6. The Nuxalk EOC is active and will work full time.
- 7. Continue to follow all precautions. **BE KIND**. This virus does not discriminate.
- 8. Check in on your elderly relatives and those with compromised immune systems by TELEPHONE only.
- 9. If you are returning HOME FROM TRAVEL, YOU MUST SELF ISOLATE FOR 7 DAYS AND STRICTLY SELF-MONITOR FOR SYMPTOMS
- 10. Limit any travel out of the valley to medical needs ONLY
- 11. Please do **NOT** invite any visitors from out-of-town.
- 12. Contact tracing is in progress
