CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 178

A bylaw to establish a local service within a portion of Electoral Area E to provide for WATER SUPPLY & DISTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS Order-In-Council No. 267 dated February 19, 1992 provides that Bella Coola Waterworks District, incorporated by Letters Patent issued May 27, 1944, be dissolved and a local service area of the Central Coast Regional District be established for the provision of the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage, and distribution of water;

AND WHEREAS the said Order-In-Council requires that the Central Coast Regional District adopt a bylaw pursuant to Section 773(2) of the Municipal Act for the provision of the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage and distribution of water not later than the 31st day of March, 1992;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Central Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The water supply and distribution service provided by the Bella Coola Waterworks District, incorporated by Letters Patent issued May 27, 1944, is hereby established as a local service for that portion of Electoral Area E shown outlined on the plan attached as Schedule "A" to this bylaw and known as "Bella Coola Water Supply and Distribution Service Area".
- 2. The Regional Board is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out and provide water supply in and for the said service area and to do all things necessary in connection therewith.
- 3. The costs of providing the service established under section 1 shall be recovered by requisition of money to be collected by the imposition of a parcel tax or frontage tax and the imposition of fees and other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw.
- 4. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually under section 804(1)(a) and (b) for the service shall be Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$ 25,000).

- 5. Should the sums recovered under Section 3 fail to meet the costs of providing the water supply and distribution service any difference may be recovered by a requisition of money to be collected by a property value tax on all land and improvements within the service area.
- 6. This bylaw may be cited as "Bella Coola Water Supply and Distribution Service Establishment Bylaw No. 178".
