CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 402

A bylaw to convert the function of Refuse Disposal to a service in Electoral Areas C, D & E of the Central Coast Regional District.

WHEREAS by Supplementary Letters Patent dated January 9, 1975 the regional district was granted the function of Division 14 - Refuse Disposal - with Electoral Areas C and D as participants;

AND WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* authorizes the regional district board to convert a function established by Supplementary Letters Patent to a service exercised under the authority of a bylaw establishing the service;

AND WHEREAS the board wishes to convert the function of maintaining, operating and regulating grounds for the disposal of refuse to a service for establishing, developing, operating, managing and maintaining a solid waste and recycling centre with Electoral Areas C, D & E as participants;

AND WHEREAS, the board has obtained the required consent of a least 2/3 of the participants of the original function;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Central Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The function of maintaining, operating and regulating grounds for the disposal of refuse as provided by Division IV Refuse Disposal of Supplementary Letters Patent dated January 9, 1975 is hereby converted and established as a service for establishing, developing, operating, managing and maintaining a solid waste and recycling centre.
- 2. The boundaries of the service area for the service established by this bylaw are the boundaries of Electoral Areas C, D & E.
- 3. The participating areas shall include Electoral Areas C, D & E.
- 4. The annual cost of providing the service shall be recovered by either or both of the following:
 - a) the requisition of money to be collected by property value taxes levied on the net taxable values of land and improvements in the service area;
 - b) other fees and charges as may be fixed by separate bylaw.

5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for this service shall be \$1.00 per \$1,000 net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.
