CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 410

A bylaw to convert the function of Airport and Facilities to a Airport and Facilities service area in Electoral Areas C, D & E of the Central Coast Regional District.

WHEREAS by Supplementary Letters Patent dated April 20, 1972 as amended by further Supplementary Letters Patent and by B.C. Regulation 149/84, Part 5, the Central Coast Regional District was empowered to undertake the function of Division I - Airport and Facilities with Electoral Areas C, D and E as participants;

AND WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* authorizes the regional district board to convert a function established by Supplementary Letters Patent to a regional district service exercised under the authority of a bylaw establishing the service;

AND WHEREAS the board wishes to convert the function of Airport and Facilities to a Regional District service with Electoral Areas C, D & E as participants;

AND WHEREAS, the board has obtained the required consent of the participants;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Central Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The function of providing and operating an Airport and Facilities in Electoral Areas C, D & E is hereby converted and established as a service of providing and operating a Airport and Facilities with Electoral Areas C, D & E participating.
- 2. The boundaries of the service area established by this bylaw are the boundaries of Electoral Areas C, D & E.
- 3. The participating areas shall include Electoral Areas C, D & E.
- 4. The annual cost of providing the service shall be recovered by either or both of the following:
 - a) the requisition of money to be collected by property value taxes levied on the net taxable values of land and improvements in the service area;
 - b) other fees and charges as may be fixed by separate bylaw.
- 5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for this service shall be \$1.00 per \$1,000 net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.
- 6. This bylaw may be cited as the "Central Coast Regional District Airport and Facilities Conversion and Service Establishment Bylaw No. 410, 2011"
