ENDED - High Streamflow Advisory – Central Coast

ISSUED: 11:15AM July 18, 2022

The River Forecast Centre is ending a High Streamflow Advisory for:

• Central Coast including the Bella Coola River, Kingcome River, Klinaklini River

Rivers in the region rose moderately from rainfall last week. Water levels have receded. The upcoming weather forecast is trending towards relatively dry conditions.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period. Be prepared and know your hazards.

The <u>River Forecast Centre</u> continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A *High Streamflow Advisory* means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A *Flood Watch* means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A *Flood Warning* means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
