### **EVACUATION ORDER**

July 21, 2023, at 17:00

Pursuant to Section 12(1) of the BC *Emergency Program Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Central Coast Regional District due to the immediate danger to life safety caused by the Trumpeter Mountain Wildfire VA1456.

Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following area:

Evacuate to Highway 20

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately.
- Gather your family, staff and guests; take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- To receive Emergency Support Services in the Williams Lake are please call 1-250-267-4861. In addition, you may self-register using the Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) tool at <a href="https://ess.gov.bc.ca/">https://ess.gov.bc.ca/</a>. Emergency Support Services will be provided only if your primary residence is on an evacuation order.
