A message from the Nuxalk Nation EOC

- As of July 21 B.C. residents will be permitted to visit
- Tourism operators will be following strict protocols when hosting guests these have been agreed upon by tourism operators at the EOC
- The checkpoint will remain in place for information gathering purposes
- Non-residents of B.C. are not permitted to enter the Valley
- If a COVID-19 case is found in the Valley tourism will immediately close
- Locals returning from travel are expected to follow guidelines including: wear a mask, social distance, avoid public spaces and self-monitor for symptoms
- Bella Coola Valley Tourism is assisting the EOC in implementing safety plans and COVID-19 protocols for all visitors
