



Community Update #10 re: Bella Coola COVID-19 cases

September 25, 2020 - there is no new data to report

(this does not mean there are no new cases/rather the system has not generated updated data)

The Nuxalk EOC is requesting that we follow COVID-19 protocols:

1. **STAY AT HOME REQUEST** for all individuals in the Nuxalk Nation until further notice. Please do not visit outside your household. This is extremely important to help stop the spread of the virus.
2. A **CURFEW** is in effect **IMMEDIATELY** from **9:30PM to 6AM** – Please expect the Safety Patrol to be doing rounds in the coming days. If there are large parties or gatherings, the RCMP will be notified.
3. **WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES – SOCIAL DISTANCE – WASH YOUR HANDS**
4. Only essential services will be provided from the band office for the next two weeks (September 12th – 26th, this may be extended)
5. The Nuxalk EOC is active and will work full time.
6. Continue to follow all precautions. **BE KIND**. This virus does not discriminate.
7. Check in on your elderly relatives and those with compromised immune systems by **TELEPHONE** only. If they need supplies please do so by dropping off at their doors while taking every precaution necessary (freshly washed hands, masks or fresh gloves)
8. If you are experiencing any symptoms, **CONTACT THE HOSPITAL IMMEDIATELY** at: **250.799.5342**. This is of utmost importance to help stop the spread of COVID-19.
9. If you are returning **HOME FROM TRAVEL, YOU MUST SELF ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS**.
10. Limit any travel out of the valley to essential needs. Cases are rising daily in the province, and we must **ALL DO OUR PART** to prevent the transmission of the virus
11. Please do **NOT** invite any visitors from out-of-town. Only by working together will we be able to contain the virus from spreading.
12. Contact tracing is in progress

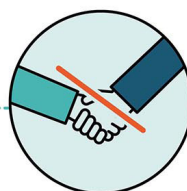
