AND WHEREAS the world, Canada and British Columbia are experiencing a pandemic;

AND WHEREAS it is anticipated Centennial Pool will reopen for the 2020 season with limited service in accordance with the COVID-19 pandemic BC Restart Plan guidance;

NOW THEREFORE, the board of directors for the Central Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw 488 cited as the "Centennial Pool Rates and Charges No. 488, 2019." is hereby repealed.
- 2. The Centennial Swimming Pool is hereby authorized to be open during such periods as may be accommodated in light of the global pandemic in accordance with the Centennial Pool COVID-19 safety plan:

June 15 to September 30<sup>TH</sup>; seven days a week, 7:00 am to 9:00 pm.
