**Disc Golf Course coming to the Central Coast Regional District**

The Central Coast Regional District (CCRD) and the Bella Coola Disc Sports Club (BCDSC) are pleased to announce the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that lays the groundwork for a new public disc golf course near the Bella Coola Airport. The MOU outlines a framework for the planning, design, and eventual installation of the course.

The CCRD is supporting the Bella Coola Disc Sports Club in this initiative through providing space within Snootli Creek Regional Park for the course and staff participation on the design team. Thanks to the volunteer efforts and leadership of the Bella Coola Disc Sports Club, this project is moving forward with no direct cost to the CCRD.

The BCDSC and the CCRD will work with Nuxalk Nation to ensure that the course will minimize environmental impacts and respect cultural heritage.
