## A-9 (a) - Facilities Inspection Policy – Airport Operations

**Preamble:** 

Inspections of the airport terminal building, runway and grounds are beneficial to the Regional District both in correcting potential safety hazards and planning for future expenditures. An inspection report will provide guidelines for the continued successful operation of the airport and will assist in ensuring that the users of the facilities have safe and reliable access.

**Policy:** 

An Aerodrome Inspection of the Bella Coola Airport will be carried out on a regular basis by personnel provided by Transport Canada. Inspection observations are in reference to the 4th edition of Transport Canada's publication "Aerodrome Standards and Recommended Practices (TP312)". Observations are classified as:

- 1) Required Improvements
- 2) Recommendations
- 3) Other

All required improvements identified by Transport Canada will be brought immediately to the attention of the CAO.

It is the responsibility of the Airport Manager to undertake the corrective actions needed and to inform and respond to Transport Canada, CCRD CAO and to the Board of Directors, as to the progress made in complying with required corrective action taken in addressing the inspection details. The Airport Manager will ensure that all Transport Canada recommendations are to be forwarded to the Accountable Executive and finance department for consideration in the budget process.
