



**EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED
#08-08
AUGUST 8, 2017, 2:00 PM**

Pursuant to *Emergency Program Act* an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Central Coast Regional District due to immediate danger to **life safety** due to a wildfire. Members of the BC Wildfire Service will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

Within the boundaries of the Central Coast Regional District as noted on the attached map dated August 8, 2017. All properties within this boundary may be impacted. The most established evacuation route is Kappan Mountain Forest Service Road to Anahim Lake and west to Bella Coola via Highway 20.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

You must leave the area **immediately**

- Follow the travel route provided and register at the Central Coast Regional District Office Emergency Social Services Reception at 626 Cliff Street, Bella Coola.
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and Keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
