The Central Coast Regional District (CCRD) provides the following responses to questions received from proponents regarding the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Airfield Pavement Rehabilitation – Engineering, issued May 1, 2026

RFP Questions and Answers

The following questions were received from potential bidders, and our responses are shown in blue.

1. Can CCRD share the 2016 Pavement Condition Survey referenced in the RFP?
The survey was actually done in 2025. See attachment at the BC Bid site.
2. Is it possible to use drone surveying to expedite the collection of ground information?
Yes, but you would be responsible to acquire the permit from Transport Canada and follow their operating requirements.
3. Does CCRD have its own technical specifications that will be used for this project, or can a standard construction contract, such as MMCD, be followed?
No, we do not have our own technical standards.
4. The RFP notes the rehabilitation of associated drainage systems at the Bella Coola Airport. Can CCRD provide additional information on the existing drainage system serving the airfield pavement areas today, and the anticipated scope of rehabilitation beyond protection of the existing infrastructure during construction?
We do not have drainage system except for light sloping and crowning for water to drain off the runway.
