Bylaw No. 566, 2026

A bylaw to establish a service to provide for Regional 9-1-1

WHEREAS the Central Coast Regional District may, by bylaw, establish and operate a Regional 9-1-1 service pursuant to the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS elector approval has been obtained by the Alternative Approval Process;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Central Coast Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

CITATION

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “Regional 9-1-1 Emergency Call Service Establishment Bylaw No. 566, 2026”.

SERVICE ESTABLISHED

2. There is hereby established a Regional 9-1-1 Service known as the “Regional 9-1-1 Emergency Call Service”.

SERVICE BOUNDARIES

3. The boundaries of the Service shall be comprised Central Coast Regional District including all Areas A, B, C, D and E.

PARTICIPATING AREA

4. All Areas (A,B,C,D and E) will participate in the service.

COST RECOVERY

5. The annual cost of providing the Service shall be recovered by one or more of the following methods in accordance with Section 378 of the *Local Government Act*:
 - a. Property Value taxes;
 - b. Parcel taxes;
 - c. Fees and charges;

- d. Revenues raised by other means authorized under the *Local Government Act* or another Act;
- e. Revenues received by way of agreement enterprise gift, grant or otherwise.
